^dIn the Gerrig & Zimbardo text, the statistical supplement following Chapter 2 was not included in the page count of Chapter 2 or given a separate chapter number. We did not include these pages in calculating pages per chapter. However, these 10 pages are included in the Text pages and Text pages plus back matter columns. In the Myers text, the Prologue section was not given a chapter number and was not classified as a preface. We did not count it as a chapter or when averaging pages per chapter. However, these 17 pages are included in the Text pages and Text pages plus back matter columns. The Baucum & Smith, Griggs, and Hinrichs textbooks include built-in study guides. For each book, these pages were included in calculating Text pages and Text pages plus back matter but were excluded in calculating pages per chapter.

^eThe Huffman text offers two optional chapters on Industrial/Organizational Psychology and Human Performance in a Global Economy. The Huffman, Kassin, and Myers texts are also available in modular formats that present the same material as their full-length texts but in smaller units. The Kassin modular version is available in a customizable format. The Feldman text is available in modular format only.
